Itinerary:

Day 1 - Travel to Weston, WV for our first night.

Day 2 - An interesting attraction takes us to the **Trans-Allegheny Lunatic Asylum**. Learn about the pioneers of humane treatment for the mentally ill and see the Civil War section of the hospital. After this orientation tour, take the **Criminally Insane Tour** and travel through areas designed to hold the criminally insane for over 100 years. Learn about the admissions process, the riot that stopped it all, and much more. Continue to **Natural Bridge, Virginia for 2 nights**. The immensity is startling...the majesty is striking...20 stories of solid rock, carved by the finger's of nature. This is Virginia's Natural Bridge. Treasured by kings, purchased by patriots, this great stone monument is the looking glass of history. Higher than Niagara, old as dawn, 90 feet wide, 215 feet tall and one of the 7 Natural Wonders of the World, Natural Bridge is nothing short of spectacular. Lodging at **Natural Bridge Historic Hotel with dinner included**. www.naturalbridgeva.com Tonight is the **Drama of Creation**, a spectacular **Sound & Light Show**. On May 22, 1927 then President Calvin Coolidge pressed the button that inaugurated the night illumination of Natural Bridge. To this, musical accompaniment was added to form a moving drama of creation, interpreted by some of the greatest symphonic compositions of all time and vocal music of unusual quality and appeal. During the night pageant, mountain sides form a vast stage. Scenes move and change with the mood of gripping music in a spectacle which takes the onlooker back into the eternal ages.

Day 3 - Tour **Thomas Jefferson's Poplar Forest Retreat** as we're invited inside Jefferson's private retreat, the home of his most personal architectural creations and the site of his individual pursuit of happiness. You'll discover award-winning, thought-provoking and meticulous historical restoration, both inside and outside, through archaeological discoveries and research that continues to uncover new knowledge about Thomas Jefferson. After lunch, tour the **National D-Day Memorial** in Bedford, VA. Imagine a place where the lessons and legacy of D-Day are remembered and preserved, a place where veterans of all ages are welcomed and honored, a place where visitors discover and recognize the worthy service of those who answered duty's call, a place where gravity and dignity are hallmarks. The National D-Day Memorial is such a place. Located on an 88 acre site, the Memorial has four major components that represent the sweep of D-Day from the early planning and preparation, through the Channel crossing and landing in France, on to the Allied victory and consolidation of the beaches, and beyond Normandy into the landscape of postwar Europe. Within these components visitors encounter a moving array of small memorials and tributes. This guided tour takes us through the climactic engagement of the Second World War, and is an experience you'll never forget. **Dinner included.**

Day 4 - Lots of highlights today including beautiful **Skyline Drive**, one of the most scenic drives in the entire National Park system. Imagine it during autumn colors! Numerous overlooks afford breathtaking views of the **Shenandoah Valley**, more than 4000 feet below. Tour **Thomas Jefferson's Monticello**, the stunning estate in the mountains. Guided tours feature the **Mansion, Gardens & Grounds and Slavery Tour**. This afternoon tour **Shenandoah Caverns** and explore the unique, incredible and intricate world of the underground. *Note: Elevator service, NO stairs and easy walking.* Overnight in **Cumberland, Maryland**. **Dinner included.**

Day 5— At the **University of Pittsburgh's Cathedral of Learning**, enjoy a guided tour of the **Nationality Rooms**. A student guide takes us on a tour designed to represent the culture of various ethnic groups that settled in Allegheny County. After lunch continue towards home.
