Day 1 - Four of Canada's best destinations are packaged into one great vacation. Travel to **Kingston, Ontario**, once Canada's Capital. Lodging right on Lake Ontario and **dinner included**. **Accommodations:** Holiday Inn-Kingston Waterfront (www.hikingstonwaterfront.com)

The basilica's copper dome, which is the highest point in Montreal, is the second largest of its kind in the world, smaller only than St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. The domes rises 856 feet above sea level. More than 3 million people visit annually. We'll also take a ride up to **Mont-Royal** to almost 800 feet to get a terrific view of stunning Montreal. Spend some time in Old Montreal and take in its European charm with cobblestone streets lined with art galleries, chic boutiques, eclectic restaurants and pubs and specialty shops. **Dinner included tonight.**

Day 4 - Breakfast included then depart for **Quebec City, one of the most beautiful cities in the world**. Join up with our guide and visit **Ste. Anne de Beaupre**, one of the recognized Basilica's of North America. An Audioguide hand held device guides you through the rich history and magnificent architecture of one of the oldest pilgrimage sites in North America. Stop at **Montmorency Falls**, 98 feet higher than Niagara Falls and a local landmark.
