Sample Itinerary:

Day 1 - Overnight in Nashville, TN area.

Day 2 - Traveling south we'll visit the Ave Maria Grotto in Cullman, Alabama. Known through the world as "Jerusalem in Miniature", is a beautifully landscaped, four-acre park designed to provide a natural setting for the 125 miniature reproductions of some of the most famous historic buildings and shrines in the world. Continue south and arrive late afternoon at the 1st class Perdido Beach Resort for (4) nights. We will stay in the Angle Beach View room with private balcony and partial view of the beach. Call Kathy @ Shoreline Tours - 1-800-265-0818 x143 to enquire about upgrade to Gulf Front Rooms. Tonight join us for a pizza party with "refreshment", beer, wine, non-alcoholic drinks.

Day 3 - Join us on a day trip to Mobile, Alabama and highlight our day with a visit to Bellingrath Gardens. Experience the Bayou Boardwalk, Mirror Lake Garden, the Great Lawn, Asian-American Gardens, the 2004 Top Public Rose Garden in the U.S., Butterfly Garden and more. Tour the stately Bellingrath Mansion, then take a delightful river cruise on the Southern Belle with lunch included. Next, tour the Mobile Carnival Museum, and discover the birthplace of Mardi Gras. See first-hand the intricate designs and artistry of majestic crowns, scepters and robes of Mardi Gras monarchs. Discover the art of costume design and float construction, and experience a behind the mask view of the street party by climbing aboard a rocking float. Or visit the USS Alabama Battleship. She began her World War II adventures in the North Atlantic in 1943. Years later she arrived in Mobile, Alabama as a National Historic Landmark and memorial to millions. Dinner included.

Day 4 - We'll spend the entire day touring and exploring Pensacola, Florida. Visit the National Naval Aviation Museum and relive special moments in American and world history. Attractions and exhibits include NC-4, Flying Boat, P.O.W. Exhibits, USS Cabot Flight Deck, WWII South Pacific, WWII Aircraft Carrier exhibit, Space, and the incredible jets of the Blue Angels. A guided tour highlights our visit. Visit the Pensacola Lighthouse and Museum which sits on an active military base. The 1859 lighthouse is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and is still an active navigational aid. Enjoy some leisure time mid-day at Pensacola's beautiful Historic District. This afternoon enjoy a Dolphin Cruise along the beautiful Santa Rosa Sound and Gulf Islands National Seashore.

Day 5 - Take a walk on the beach as we enjoy a morning at your leisure. Later, take a day trip to Fairhope, Alabama, known as the "Jewel of the Eastern Shore". A lovely village is filled with galleries, specialty shops and 80 charming shops.

OPTIONAL EXCURSIONS: Golf or Deep Sea Fishing.

Later visit Florabama, a popular Oyster & Package Bar right on the Florida/Alabama border. Happy Hour is on Shoreline! Conclude with dinner at Lucy Buffet's LuLu's, Jimmy sister. Enjoy a casual waterfront atmosphere and entertainment that follows dinner.

Day 6 - En route to New Orleans for (2) nights, stop in Bayou for a the Honey Island Swamp Tour. There are about one million alligators in Louisiana and our guide takes us right into the heart of "Gator Country". Lodging in New Orleans at the Crown Plaza French Quarter. (www.astorneworleans.com) Evening at your leisure.

Day 7 - A sightseeing tour highlights our morning. Learn the history of the original city, the French Quarter, and why it was built at this particular location along the Mississippi River. You'll also get an eyewitness account of the events surrounding Hurricane Katrina, "America's Worst Catastrophe". Learn a local's chronology of events leading up to Katrina and the days immediately following the disaster. The afternoon is free to explore the French Quarter. Dinner concludes a memorable day.

Day 8 - En route to Nashville we'll stop for a guided tour of the Birmingham Civil Rights Institute. Their mission is promoting civil and human rights worldwide through education. Richly detailed exhibits reveal slices of black and white life in Alabama from the 1800's to the present. Overnight in the Nashville area.

Day 9 - Homeward bound.
