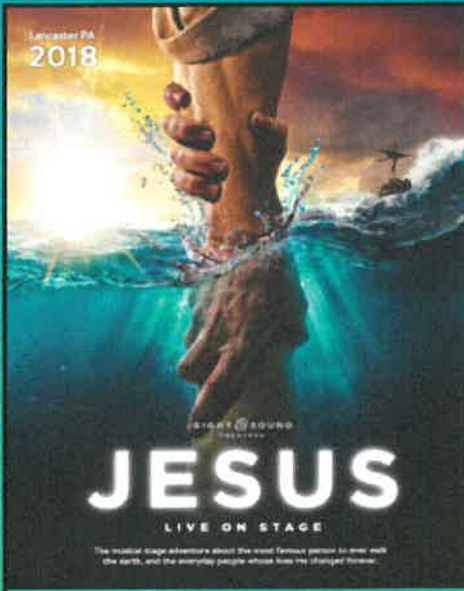

Sample Itinerary:

Day 1—Travel to **Lancaster County and Penn Dutch Country** for a jam-packed spring getaway. Lodging for **(3) nights** at the **Best Western Plus** in Intercourse, PA. Surrounded by the beauty of the Amish Country, this newly renovated hotel designed with rustic style architecture fits perfectly into the charm of the area.

Day 2—An exciting day trip brings us to historic **Gettysburg**. The Battle of Gettysburg was a turning point in the Civil War, the Union victory that ended General Robert E. Lee’s second and most ambitious invasion of the North. Often referred to as the “High Water Mark of the Rebellion”, Gettysburg was the Civil War’s bloodiest battle and was also the inspiration for President Abraham Lincoln’s immortal “Gettysburg Address”. Our visit features a **guided tour of the Gettysburg Battlefield**. Also **visit the Museum of the Civil War** featuring relics of the Battle of Gettysburg and personalities who served in the Civil War. The restored **Gettysburg Cyclorama** depicts the final fury of Gettysburg—”Pickett’s Charge”. Also **view the film “A New Birth to Freedom”**, narrated by Morgan Freeman. A full day concludes with **dinner included at the historic Dobbin House Restaurant**. After dinner meet **President Abe Lincoln**, in a deep in-character portrayal of the President.

Day 3—Discover **Pennsylvania’s Amish Countryside**, a picturesque landscape of rolling hills with lush grasses and crops, farms with windmills dotting the horizon and horse and buggies sharing the roads. A morning **History & Heritage Tour in Pennsylvania Dutch Country** immerses us in the stories and places where ordinary people with extraordinary determination changed our nation’s history. Visit the **Amish Quilt & Craft Shop** and see why people come from all over the world to purchase quilts made by Amish and Mennonite women. Enjoy some leisure time mid-day at **Kitchen Kettle Village**, showcasing a charming collection of specialty shops. Next, is **Chalk Talk at Elva’s Studio**. Engage your senses through music, storytelling, and the amazing chalk artistry of faith and forgiveness as it pertains to the Plain People of Lancaster County. **Dinner is included** followed by the incredible performance of **“JESUS”** at Lancaster’s **Sight & Sound Theatre**.
