SAMPLE ITINERARY

DAY 1 - Motorcoach to Toronto for our first overnight. Lodging in downtown Toronto. Tonight join us at the **Famous People Players Dinner Theatre**, a terrific way to start your vacation. From the moment you step inside, you will experience a splendor to all your senses and a magical night you'll never forget (www.fpp.org).

DAY 2 - **Breakfast included** then take a morning **sightseeing tour of Toronto**. This afternoon fly non-stop to Halifax and begin our Nova Scotia vacation. Almost completely surrounded by ocean, Nova Scotia is truly **one of the world's best destinations**. Discover stunning scenic routes, world-famous lighthouses, pristine coastline, fine dining and incredibly friendly locals. **Dinner included**. Accommodations at the **Hampton Inn - Downtown Halifax**.

DAY 3 - **Breakfast included**. A **sightseeing tour of Halifax**, the capital of Nova Scotia, highlights our morning. This will delight all who love the ocean as it affords exquisite panoramas of countless islands and coves, among which is Oak Island where people still dig in search of Captain Kidd's long-buried treasures. Return mid-afternoon to our hotel and the rest of the day is at your leisure. We'll suggest you visit **Halifax Historic Properties**. Constructed in the late 1700's, the area has 10 of the cities oldest buildings, including 7 which have been designated **National Historic Sites**. Few North American cities can boast such a concentration of history and heritage, coupled with world-class shopping, fine dining, unique pubs and more.

DAY 4 - **Breakfast included**. Travel scenic **Marine Drive** passing through quaint fishing villages and the Atlantic Coastline before heading inland en route to **Cape Breton Island**, recognized as the **4th best island to visit in the world**. Visit the **Bell Museum**, which contains a remarkable collection of **Alexander Graham Bell's** early inventions. Lodging for two nights at the 4-star **Gisele's Country Inn**. (www.giseles.com) **Dinner included** at their award-winning restaurant.

DAY 5 - **Breakfast included**. Today is devoted to **sightseeing of Cape Breton** and along the **Cabot Trail**. Leaving Baddeck, the countryside becomes more rugged as the **Cabot Trail**, **one of the most scenic and spectacular highways on the continent**, winds through **Cape Breton Highlands National Park**...past majestic rock bluffs, over the summit of lofty peaks...and through deep stream-lined valleys. Views of the rocky shoreline are magnificent. A special **lunch is included** at **The Keltic Lodge**, perched high on a bluff overlooking the Atlantic Ocean. We're back at our inn late afternoon and **dinner included**.

DAY 6 - **Breakfast included**. Board a **ferry** for **Prince Edward Island**, crossing the Northumberland Strait. **Prince Edward Island** is Canada's smallest province, yet one of the most beautiful. A sunny day on the island is a memorable and charming experience. The sun pours out warmth on the special island, igniting the fiery red soil, nurturing the green pastoral fields and warming over 500 miles of sandy beaches. Situated on the **Gulf of St. Lawrence**, it is home to the farmer, fisherman, laborer and businessman, a pleasing blend of lifestyles. Accommodations at the **Rodd Royalty Hotel**. (www.roddvacations.com) A **lobster dinner** is included.

DAY 7 - **Breakfast included**. Our local guide takes us on a **sightseeing tour** of Canada's most charming province. Travel through tiny fishing villages and along beautiful beaches into **Prince Edward Island National Park**. Visit **Anne of Green Gables Home**, the literary home of Anne of Green Gables. Enjoy a bit of leisure time in beautiful downtown Charlottetown. This evening, join us for a **performance or Anne of Green Gables Musical or an alternate show**.

DAY 8 - **Breakfast included**. The **Confederation Bridge** joins **P.E.I. and Moncton, New Brunswick**. We will return from P.E.I. via the bridge, allowing us some different sights along the way. The curved, 8 mile long bridge is the longest in the world and a decade after its construction, it endures as one of Canada's top engineering achievements of the 20th century. Arriving in Moncton We'll visit the magnificent **Bay of Fundy** and watch in wonder as you experience the **Hopewell Rocks** with a guided tour. It is a place to pause...a place to appreciate a remarkable story interwoven through time, tide and the intricacies of nature. These are the **highest tides in the world** and they happen twice a day. Our tour **includes lunch** and highlights the dramatic rock face, majestic sheer cliffs, and beautiful ocean views as we learn about the natural and cultural history of the region. Late afternoon arrive in **Halifax** for our last overnight. Accommodations at **Hampton Inn-Downtown Halifax**. Enjoy an **included farewell dinner** tonight.
